## Matthew 23:23 - Mercy the weightier matter in the Law

Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice, mercy, and faith.

## Hebrews 4:16 - Come to God in order to obtain mercy

Come boldly to the throne of grace, that you may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

### Lamentations 3:22-23 - His mercies are renews every morning

Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are renewed every morning; great is Your faithfulness.

Genesis 2:16, 17 - Adam and Eve, though under a death sentence, did not die And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the very day that you eat of it you shall surely die." Adam sinned but lived to have children, and raise his family, until he died at age 930.

Steps to Christ, p. 95 - Our need pleads in our defense in God's courtroom
